
Bushy Run Battlefield Buy-a-Brick Campaign



In 2013, the Bushy Run Battlefield Heritage Society (BRBHS) unveiled a new monument in honor of the 250th Anniversary of the Battle of Bushy Run. It was the first monument to be installed at the battlefield in over 100 years.

The monument is located at the site of the first day's action that occurred on August 5, 1763. Artists Robert Griffing and John Buxton designed the monument concept and bronze sculptor Wayne Hyde vividly brought their design to life.

BRBHS continues a fundraising campaign for the monument through the sale of engraved bricks. All funds raised through this program go directly to the costs associated with the upkeep of the monument.
